- 1. Editorial** – work alongside the editor to develop magazine and produce editorial comment and front page. Research and help to establish connections with arts and news media.
Requirement: *Keen committed writer with an eye for detail.*
- 2. Creative Writing and the Arts** – work alongside the Creative Writing and Arts Editor on fiction and poetry as well as student news related to music, drama and the arts.
Requirement: *Keen writer who enjoys the arts.*
- 3. Competitions and Language** – work alongside the editor for school-wide competitions and language.
Requirement: *Organised, full of ideas, and willing to research and report about use of language in the school and community.*
- 4. Newsroom and Business** – work as a school reporter together with News Editor and Business Director. Help to establish links with Brixton business.
Requirement: *Willing to develop skills as a reporter/writer and interest in business.*
- 5. Culture and Business** – work as a researcher/reporter on cultural affairs in school and community alongside the Cultural Editor and Business Editor. Help to establish links with businesses in local area.
Requirement: *Willing to research and develop skills as a reporter/writer and interest in business.*
- 6. Science & Innovation** – work as a school reporter/researcher alongside Science & Innovation Editor.
Requirement: *Keen interest in science and willing to develop writing skill.*
- 7. Magazine Layout and Production** – Work alongside Production Editor to set up magazine online, as well as help with the organisation of printing copies.
Requirement: *Artistic, organised and willing to develop computer skills.*
